### Understands the Value of Fine Arts

- Fine Arts: Creative art forms, whose products are to appreciated primarily or solely for their imaginative, aesthetic, or intellectual content
- Painting, sculpture, architecture, music, poetry, theatre, dance

## Implements Technology to Enhance Research Projects

### Technology:

- <u>Equipment</u> developed from the application of scientific knowledge. (the primary definition for our purposes)
- The <u>practical application</u> of scientific knowledge, particularly in industry and science (e.g. computer technology)
- What are some types of technical equipment that you interact with while doing your research? How does technology change the way you work? What are the potential hazards of technology in research?
- What are some ways in which you apply your scientific knowledge and research skills?
- Why is this SLE important?
- How will this help in the future?

### Puts Forth Effort to Achieve Academic Potential

- What does academic potential mean?
  - Academic: having to do with education
  - Potential: showing or having the capacity to become something in the future
- Is academic potential equal in all students?
- Can you measure your academic potential? How do you know when you have achieved it?
- How have your educational successes and growth been measured at STA?
- Why is it important to put forth effort to achieve your academic potential?
- How will this help you in the future?

### Uses Critical Thinking Skills to Process Information

Critical Thinking Skills:

- 1. Knowledge
- 2. Comprehension
- Application
- 4. Analvsis
- 5. Svnthesis
- 6. Evaluation

Critical thinking is <u>not</u> just "thinking hard" about something! When we think critically, we use a set of practiced and acquired skills to process information.

# An Effective Communicator Who

## Applies the Skills of an Active Listener

Skills of an Active Listener:

- Be attentive
- Ask open-ended questions
- Ask probing questions
- Request clarification
- Paraphrase
- Be attuned to and reflect feelings
- Summarize

# Articulates Beliefs and Opinions Respectfully and with Conviction

### **Demonstrates Manners and Etiquette Appropriately**

#### Manners:

- Please
- Thank you
- No interrupting
- Excuse me
- Ask permission
- Knock on closed doors
- Treat others with respectPretend to be interested

#### Etiquette:

- Different behavior expectations for different situations
- Social etiquette
- Church etiquette
- Telephone etiquette
- Eating etiquette
- Classroom etiquette

Etiquette provides the form or structure within which good manners can operate.

# A Responsible Individual Who

## Strives to Live a Balanced Lifestyle

### Accepts Challenges and Pursues Goals

- Why is it important to accept challenges and pursue goals?
  - What impact does accepting challenges and pursuing goals have on your life?
- How will accepting challenges and pursuing goals help you in the future?

### Analyzes Options when Making Choices

Analysis: a detailed examination of anything complex in order to understand its nature or determine its essential features: a thorough study

- How do you analyze?
  - Identify the situation
  - Identify your options
  - Use prior knowledge to better understand your options
  - Use prior knowledge and understanding to make an informed decision
  - Why is it important to analyze your options when making choices?
- How will developing the ability to analyze options when making choices help you in the future?
